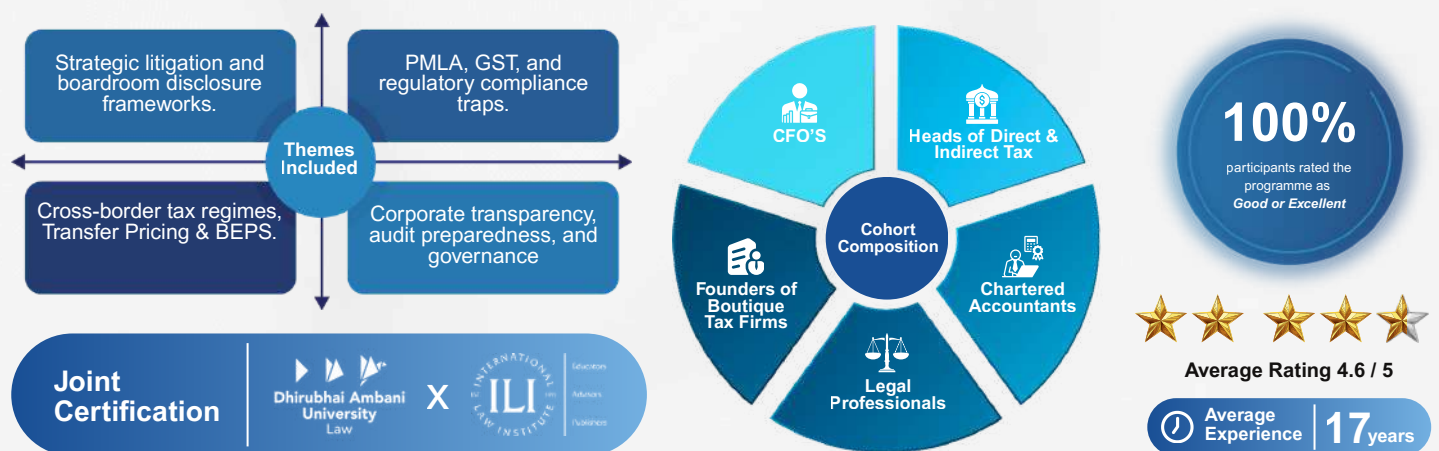
# Building on Success: Announcing the 3rd Edition

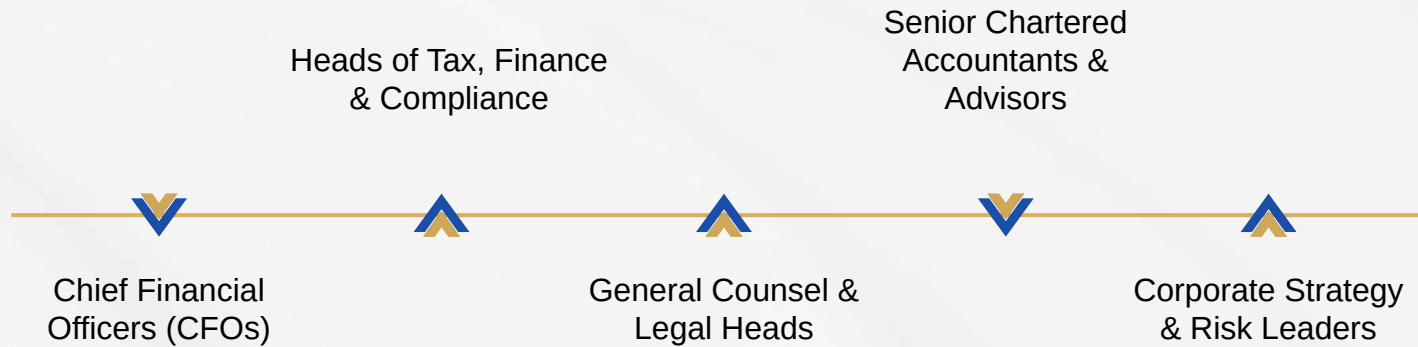

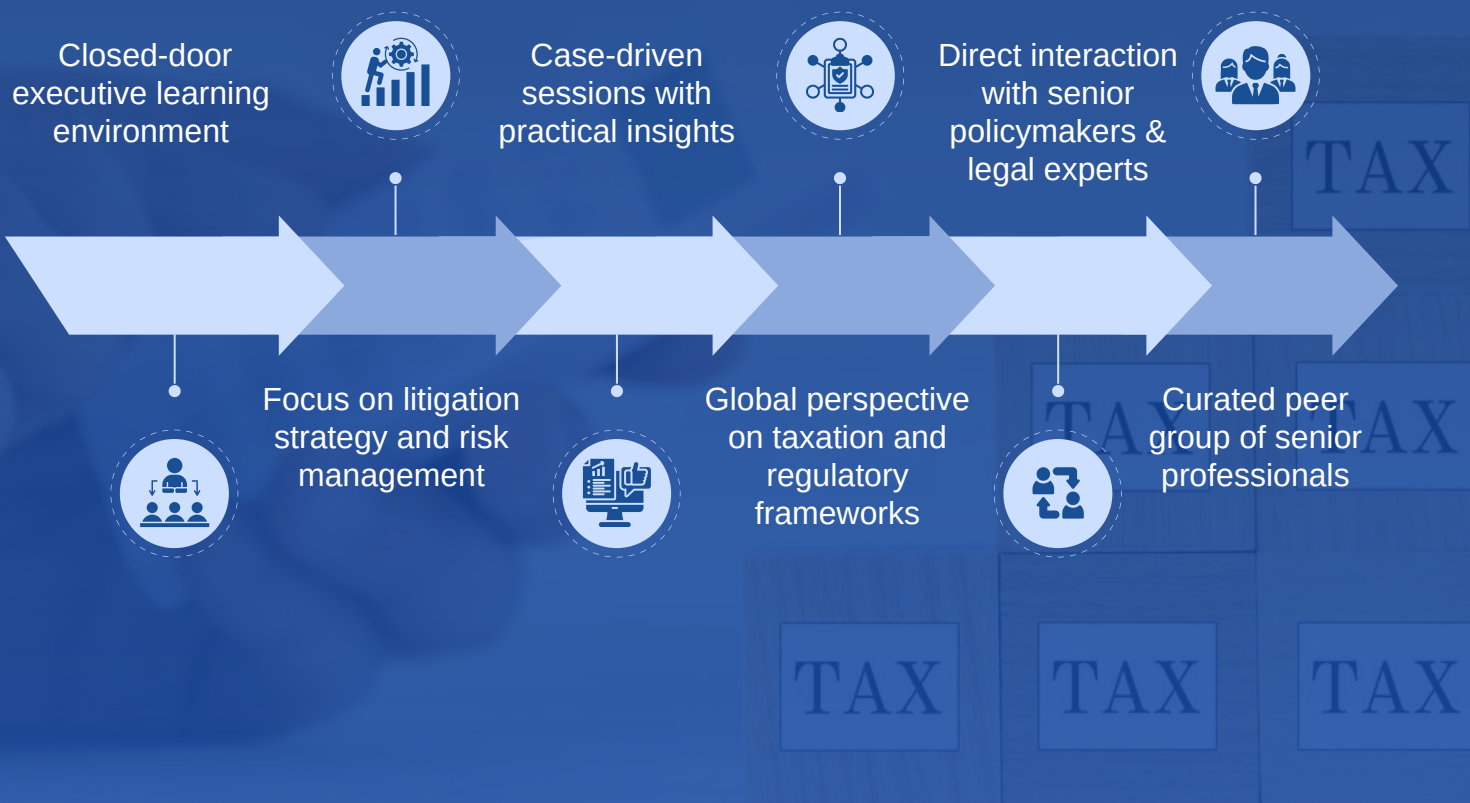
